The College Level Examination Program (CLEP) is a credit-by-examination program offered by the College Board that provides standardized tests across a diverse array of college-level courses. Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts participates in this national program and encourages students to speak with their advisor before registering for a CLEP Examination. For each CLEP examination that awards 3 or 6 credits, MCLA requires a minimum score of 50, representing the mean test score of students who earn a C in the corresponding college level course.
