NOTICE TO BIDDERS – PROJECT # MCLA-P035

Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts, the Awarding Authority, invites written responses from contractors for the **Amsler Campus Center Waste Pipeline Replacement** Project in North Adams, Massachusetts.

Scope of Work:

In general, the project includes all labor, materials, equipment and supervision necessary to replace sections of a deteriorated cast iron waste pipeline in the MCLA Amsler Campus Center.

- *Remove and replace approximately 25 feet of 4" cast iron horizontal waste pipe, fittings and hangers including old bell and spigot double wye.*
- *Remove and replace approximately 25 feet of 4" cast iron vertical waste pipe, fittings and hangers.*
- *Work will include set-up/take down of staging to gain access to pipe and to removal and replace a section of ductwork.*

Clean-up / Closeout:

Final clean-up of area shall be by the contractor. All trash, excess materials, etc. shall be removed from site and disposed of properly and legally. Contractor must conduct a close out meeting with MCLA project manager.

Completion: Tuesday March 15, 2022

A **mandatory** pre-bid walkthrough will take place on Thursday, March 3, 2022 at 11:00 am. The gathering point for the walkthrough will be in the MCLA Facilities Building at 341 Ashland Street, North Adams MA 01247. All visitors are required to wear a mask while on campus and inside college buildings.

Prevailing wage rates to be paid on this project have been determined by the Commissioner of Labor and Industries under the provisions of Section 26 and 27, Chapter 149 and/or Chapter 30 Section 39A of the General Laws. All responses for this project are subject to the provisions of either or both Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 30, Section 39M as amended and Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Sections 44A – 441 inclusive. Prevailing wage rates for this project can be obtained by sending a request to william.norcross@mcla.edu.

If the contract price exceeds \$25,000, the selected contractor must furnish the awarding authority with a payment bond for 50% of the total value of the bid.

Contractors must be able to furnish Labor Harmony and OSHA training certification requirements.
